[Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0] for the 2nd quarter of 2025-26.

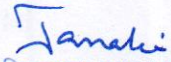
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Department of Food & Public Distribution's OM No.4-4/2025-BP II (e-388739) dated 26.03.2025 and F.No.4-1/2024-BP II dated 19.02.2025 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India for allocation of **893.71 (Eight Hundred Ninety Three Metric Tons and Seven Hundred Ten Kilograms only) MTs of Wheat and 383.02 (Three Hundred Eight Three Metric Tons and Twenty Kilograms only) MTs of Fortified Rice** at Central Issue Price (CIP) applicable for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under the **Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG)** to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh under SAG for the 2nd quarter of 2025-26.

2. The quantity of foodgrains allocated during 2025-26 should be lifted as per Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.4-7/2018-BP.II dated 25.04.2019 and will be used for the beneficiaries of the SAG only. The State Governments are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting & utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

3. State Governments is requested to furnish the Utilization Certificate for the food grains allocated under SAG from 2015-16 to 2024-25 at the earliest, if not furnished earlier, and ensure timely submission of the off take/UC for the food grains allocated vide this sanction order at the earliest at jviswanathan.edu@nic.in.

4. State Governments is also requested to intimate the end use of the food grains allocated under Scheme for Adolescent Girls along with the off take figures and Utilization Certificates (UCs).

5. The cost of the food grains shall be payable by the State Government to the Food Corporation of India (FCI).

6. The State Government may indent the allocated quantity of food grains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India (FCI). Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of food grains to the State Governments. In the meantime, district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of food grains may be worked out and copies of the same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.

7. The Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Governments to ensure that the quantity of food grains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of food grains released by this Ministry under the Scheme.

8. State Government of Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, West Bengal and UT of A&N Islands may be allowed to draw their allocations from the DCP stocks under Decentralized Procurement System (DCP) vide letter No. 13-1/2012-BP-II dated 14.02.2012 received from Department of Food and Public distribution.

9. The above allocation has been made based on the Aadhaar verified beneficiaries minus opt out beneficiaries' data as available in the Poshan Tracker as on 31.01.2025 in pursuance of this Ministry's letter No.17/2/2025-CD III (e-120722) dated 24.02.2025.

10. This issues with the approval of Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development vide Dy. No. 17/1/2025-CD-III (e-120279) dated 14.05.2025.
