Minutes of the meeting of Programme Approval Board (PAB) for the FY 2023-24 held during the month of May and June, 2023 to consider proposals of States / UTs under Mission Shakti.

The PAB Meeting for the FY 2023-24 under Mission Shakti was held under chairpersonship of Shri Indavar Pandey, Secretary, MWCD during the month of May and June, 2023 at (i) New Delhi (8th May, 2023; 16th May, 2023; 30th May, 2023; and 06th June, 2023), (ii) Shillong (12th May, 2023), (iii) Pune (19th May, 2023) and (iv) Kochi (02nd June, 2023) to consider the proposals of States/ UTs for financial assistance for ongoing projects as well as for approval of new projects. During these meetings, an initial presentation was made by Dr. Preetam B. Yashvant, JS, Ms. Pallavi Agarwal, JS and Ms. Preeti Pant, JS on respective components being looked after by them, outlining the pending issues of the Ministry with the respective States/ UTs. Thereafter, States/ UTs made their respective presentations giving status of implementation of various components of Mission Shakti and also submitted their new proposals for consideration of PAB. After detailed presentations and deliberations, the PAB took decisions and made certain observations, which are summarised below:

A. Sambal

One Stop Centres (OSC)

1. Proposals of States / UTs for setting up of new / additional One Stop Centres- these included proposals for (i) construction of new buildings for existing OSCs running in pre-existing building and (ii) approval for additional OSCs (iii) approval for OSCs in new districts in new building/ pre-existing building.
2. It has been observed that in many cases, the construction of OSC buildings have not commenced over a long period of time due to non-submission of proof of land by the District/ State Administrations. It was decided that instead of furnishing the sale/ transfer deed as proof of land document, a certificate from the competent authority of States Government/ UTs regarding the availability of land (of prescribed size/ area) would be taken into consideration to sanction the OSCs for construction. The requirement of cost estimates of construction and other requirement as per scheme guidelines would remain. The details of approval for new proposal for OSCs is at **Annexure – I**.
3. All the proposals for setting up of new / additional OSCs and construction of building of OSCs would be implemented as per financial norms indicated in the guidelines of Mission Shakti. The SNA Accounts at State level and Zero Balance Child Account at district level for all the additional OSCs to be opened immediately and mapped with PFMS for facilitating release of funds.
4. All the States/ UTs were advised to ensure proper data entry in Sakhi Dashboard and maintain the directory of all the relevant authorities including police, hospitals, and statutory officers under various laws etc. for providing speedy assistance to needy women.
5. It was also advised that wherever funds for construction of building for OSCs have been released by the Ministry, immediate action be taken to complete the construction and wherever required, the prescribed documents may be submitted for facilitating release of 2nd installment of construction grant.
6. All the States/ UTs were requested to ensure that the OSCs are properly staffed as per the scheme guidelines and the OSCs have all the prescribed infrastructure/ facility available with them.

7. Several States/ UTs raised the issue that within the budget provided by the Ministry for hiring of vehicles for the OSCs, they are finding it difficult to arrange for the vehicle and requested to provide more funds for the purpose. It was informed that the matter will be examined in the Ministry.
8. It was informed that the Cabinet has approved the proposal of the Ministry for rationalization and closure of Central Social Welfare Board (CSWB) in its meeting held on 06.04.2023 which was conveyed vide Closure cell OM dated 12th & 13th April, 2023 to all States/ UTs. The time schedule for closure activities has also been drawn. In this backdrop, a policy decision is being taken by the Ministry that the Family Counselling Centres (FCCs) under CSWB would continue to work under the aegis of One Stop Centre (OSC) under Mission Shakti. The financial, administrative and operational details will be shared with the States/UTs once a final decision is taken.

Women Helpline (WHL)

9. The Ministry would provide funds for implementation of Women Helpline (WHL) component as per provisions of the guidelines of Mission Shakti.
10. With regard to integration of Women Helpline 181 with Emergency Response Support System (ERSS-112) and OSCs, Joint Secretary (WW), MWCD informed that Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC) has installed hardware for integrated WHL 181 in 12 States/ UTs and hardware for the OSCs have already been dispatched to seven states. The hardware in the remaining States/ UTs would be soon dispatched and installed by C-DAC. While C-DAC has been making endeavour to supply the equipment in all States/ UTs at the earliest, the State Governments/ UT administrations have to simultaneously ensure shifting of existing WHL to the integrated WHL being installed by C-DAC at the earliest possible. To begin with, the State Governments/ UT administrations were requested to move manpower, if required, to get it functional in a time bound manner. JS (WW), MWCD assured that the Ministry would soon be issuing instructions along with SOP for all States/ UTs in this regard. All States/ UTs were also requested to extend necessary assistance to C-DAC for automation and integration of WHL and Childline with ERSS and their linkage with OSCs / DCPUs and complete the exercise at the earliest.
11. The States were requested to open the SNA accounts for WHL at Directorate / Secretariat level at the earliest. Funds for WHL would not be released to Districts henceforth.

Nari Adalat

12. The Scheme will be implemented in the first phase in Jammu & Kashmir and Assam.

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP)

13. The implementation of BBBP component would be as per provisions indicated in the operational Manual and guidelines of Mission Shakti. All States/ UTs were also requested to adhere to the SNA guidelines and submit the necessary documentation to the Ministry at the earliest for facilitating further release of funds.

B. Samarthya

Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)

14. Sh. Preetam B Yashvant, Joint Secretary, Mission Shakti, MWCD, outlined several important points relating to the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) that are applicable across all states, including the transfer of funds from the Escrow account to the SNA account for all States and UTs with legislatures. Additionally, it was emphasized that DBT enablement and Annexure-III mapping of SNA Accounts for PMMVY 2.0 should be ensured.
15. Similarly, States/ UTs were requested to expedite enrollment in the new portal available at <http://pmmvy.nic.in>.
16. Other crucial steps that need to be taken both at State/ UT level and NIC, MWCD level include ensuring all master data mapping and user creation of SNOs, SO, Supervisors, AWW/ ASHA.
17. Further, it was informed that the time frame for claiming benefits has also been reduced to 270 days from the child's date of birth. The field functionaries are expected to register all women for the second girl child born between 01.04.2022 and 31.03.2023 proactively. This registration must be completed by 15.08.2023.
18. NIC was directed to ensure that reports and dashboard are available on the portal at all levels, namely Ministry, State, District, Block, and Village level. The States/ UTs were informed that a single nodal contact person, Ms. Madhuri Sharma, Adviser (IT), MWCD, has been designated to handle all IT-related issues and ad-hoc requests for data.
19. In addition, during the meetings, a few States/ UTs, namely Andaman And Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra And Nagar Haveli And Daman And Diu, Ladakh, Lakshadweep, and Meghalaya requested for lowering the indicative yearly target for beneficiary enrollment under the programme citing low target achievement over the years. In this respect, the revised tentative target for States/ UTs is indicated in **Annexure – II**. The tentative target mentioned in the minutes of PAB will be taken as an indicative target for developing an understanding related to enrollment and subsequent fund allocation and disbursement. However there is no restriction on number of enrollment for first or second child (subject to adherence of conditions mentioned in scheme guidelines) and payment as the targets are indicative only.
20. Rajasthan and some other States have requested that the NFSA Card should also be considered as supporting document for income proof and also requested to get the mobile app to be operationalized at the earliest. The chairperson assured to look into the suggestion.
21. Madhya Pradesh stated that data for more than 1 lakh beneficiaries is pending to be migrated to new portal for approval of payments. The pendency is leading to a lot of grievances in the CM Helpline. The same has been highlighted by other states during the meetings. The chairperson directed NIC to review the historical data and resolve the problem faced by the States/ UTs at the earliest.
22. Further, Madhya Pradesh suggested that all the payments to beneficiaries should be Aadhar linked payments and therefore, bank details may be fetched directly from NPCI portal during the filling of form/ registration on the portal. The chairperson agreed on the suggestion of fetching bank details directly from NPCI portal and instructed NIC to incorporate the said functionality in the PMMVY portal.

PALNA

23. It was informed that for any fund to be released from Government of India, SNA compliance should be completed. All the implementing agencies either State or District Administration or NGO or any other civil society organisations, should be mapped as an IA in PFMS for release of funds.
24. The States/ UTs were informed that as per information received from them, a total of 2688 stand alone crèches have been reported to be functional upto May 2023 (details at **Annexure – III**). States/ UTs were requested to review functioning of all the standalone crèches and to put in place proper mechanism to monitor the working of these crèches.
25. It was also informed that the above data pertaining to stand alone crèches, will only be taken into account for the FY 2023-24 and no change in the same would be entertained by the Ministry with regard to increase in the number of standalone crèches.
26. It has already been communicated to all the States / UT Administrations that all the Stand alone crèches should be closed or merged in a phased manner till FY 2024-25. Accordingly, half of the existing 2688 stand alone crèches i.e. 1416 creches should be converted to anganwadi cum crèche during FY 2023-24 and remaining 1272 stand alone crèches should be merged with nearest Anganwadi Center or be closed by the end of FY 2024-25 as indicated at Annexure-III.
27. States / UT Administration were requested to identify the stand alone crèches in their respective jurisdiction out of the 1416 numbers as mentioned in preceding para, which need to be closed or merged during the current FY. Accordingly, no further grants for functioning of those 1416 stand alone creches will be released by the Ministry after FY 2023-24.
28. It was informed to the participants that the matter of embezzlement of funds in clear violation of financial rules of Government of India by the Indian Council for Child Welfare (ICCW) has been transferred to CBI and CBI had registered an FIR in the matter. This matter has been informed to the Principal Secretaries/ Secretaries attached with Hon'ble Governors and Lt. Governors with the request to bring this to the notice of Hon'ble Governors and Lt. Governors. Also, the State Department of WCD/ Social Welfare were informed about the matter of ICCW and requested to note the gravity of the subject and take suitable action in the matter to disassociate themselves with the functioning/ activities of ICCW. It was clarified that the Ministry will not be releasing funds for the crèches run by ICCW in future.
29. During and after PAB of FY 2022-23, a total of 2497 Anganwadi-cum-creches were approved and communicated to the States/ UTs. The States/ UTs were requested to ensure that the approved crèches are fully functional.
30. The details of proposals for setting of anganwadi cum Creche for FY 2023-24 received from States/ UTs and approved by the PAB are at **Annexure – IV**.
31. The State of Mizoram informed that it has 175 central govt. funded stand alone crèches, out of which 155 stand alone creches has been proposed to be merged with nearest Anganwadi centres and be converted to Anganwadi-cum-creches. Mizoram has further requested that remaining 20 creches may remain stand alone as they are located in jails, market, Govt. Complex, BSUP, where there is no Anganwadi Centre available. The chairperson directed that the matter be examined separately and outcome be communicated to the State.
32. It was informed that as per inputs received during PABs for FY 2022-23 and after detailed consultations with states and UTs, the revised budgetary provision has been processed. As soon as the revised budgetary provisions are approved by the competent authority, the same will communicated to States/ UTs. Financial assistance for approved

Anganwadi-cum-creches for FY 2022-23 and 2023-24 will be provided to States/ UTs accordingly.

33. As revised proposal is under process, the States/ UTs were requested to send their proposals for establishment of Anganwadi cum crèches once the revised cost norms are approved and conveyed to States/ UTs.
34. The details of all the proposed Anganwadi cum Creches from States/ UTs should be intimated to the Ministry at the earliest.

Shakti Sadan and Sakhi Niwas

35. It was conveyed to all States/UTs that as per Scheme guidelines, all existing Homes currently being run/ operated by NGOs (Homes not set up by the State/ UT Governments) are permitted to run till 31.03.2024 giving sufficient time to States/ UTs to get these integrated into the new scheme. No request for extension of time limit will be entertained.
36. Utilization Certificate and Statement of Expenditure (duly signed and stamped) for pending liabilities may be submitted only on designated Sanction/ UC/ SOE portal of MWCD. Link of the portal is <https://164.100.55.24/ucsoe/>.
37. State/ UTs were advised to ensure that only 01 SNA account in the name of Shakti Sadan is opened and mapped with PFMS. All other accounts opened in the name of Swadhar Greh or Ujjawala may be closed.
38. The States/ UTs were advised to open Jan Dhan Account with Aadhaar number of the beneficiaries of Shakti Sadans.
39. The summary of proposals considered in PAB meeting under Shakti Sadan and Sakhi Niwas are indicated in **Annexure – V**.

Hub for Empowerment of Women (HEW)

40. The States/ UTs were advised to take all necessary steps including identification of location, sourcing of manpower and procurement of equipments etc. for operationizing the HEWs at State and district level by 15th August 2023 as decided in the 2nd National Conference of Chief Secretaries held in January, 2023. All the State/ UTs informed that they are in the process of setting up of SHEW and DHEW.
41. The representatives of State of Odisha and West Bengal informed that the HEW component is not likely to be implemented in their respective States. However, they will communicate the same once a final decision is taken by the State Government.
42. It was informed that in respect of 30 States/ UTs funds have been released by the Ministry. However, in case of Goa, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Sikkim, funds could not be released due to non-opening and mapping of SNA account. They were requested to take immediate appropriate action to open and map SNA account with PFMS so that funds may be released by the Ministry.

Follow up on Action Points emerged during the 2nd National Conference of Chief Secretaries.

43. All the States/ UTs were requested to take immediate necessary action and coordinate with the other relevant departments at State/ UT level for compliance of the decisions taken during the 2nd National Conference of Chief Secretaries and continue to update the Ministry on regular basis.
