I am directed to refer to Department of Food & Public Distribution's (DFPD) OM No.4-2/2026-BP II (e-391714) dated 03.06.2026 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India for allocation of **2,38,009.26 MTs (Two Lakh Thirty Eight Thousand Nine Metric Tons and Two Hundred Sixty Kilograms only) of Wheat and 1,69,091.65 MTs (One Lakh Sixty Nine Thousand Ninety One Metric Tons and Sixty Hundred Fifty only) of Rice to the following State Governments/UT Administrations against the quantity mentioned against each** under the Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP) and National Food Security Act (NFSA) at the subsidized price not exceeding Rs.2/-per kg for Wheat and Rs.3/- per kg for Rice for the 2nd quarter of the year 2026-27:

2. The above allocation has been made in pursuance of this Ministry's letter No.17/2/2026-CD III (e-143158) dated 06.04.2026 (copy enclosed). Due to increase in THR/HCM beneficiary data during February/March 2026, additional allocation of foodgrains have also been made to the concerned States/UTs, during this quarter, in accordance with this Ministry's policy guidelines dated 06.04.2026. Millets (Coarse grains) will be allocated to the States and UTs on receipt of confirmation of their availability from DFPD.

3. The allocated food grains should be lifted as per the guidelines laid down vide the Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No. 1-2/2007-BP.II, dated 27th June, 2011 and will be used for the beneficiaries of the Mission Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 Scheme only. The State Governments/UT Administrations are accordingly requested to ensure the lifting of foodgrains within the validity period & also utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

4. The cost of food grains shall be payable by the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations to the Food Corporation of India (FCI).

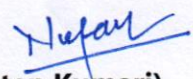
5. The State Governments and UTs may indent the allocated quantity of food grains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of food grains to the State Govt./UT Administration. Meanwhile, District-wise and Block-wise allocation of requirement of food grains may also be worked out and copies of the same may be sent to the Regional/District Offices of FCI and to this Ministry.

6. The stocks once issued to the State Govts./UT Administrations will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the respective State Govts./UT Administrations to ensure that the quantity of foodgrains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment at the prescribed rates in respect of foodgrains released by this Ministry under the Scheme.

7. All States Govts./UT Administrations are requested to furnish the consolidated Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the foodgrains allocated to them during the FY 2025-26 by 30.04.2026, in the prescribed proforma shared with the State Governments/UTs.

8. This issues with the approval of Secretary, Ministry of Women & Child Development vide Dy. No. 17/2/2026-CD-III (e-143158) dated 27.05.2026.

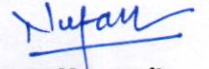
